

## Praying The Psalms

### **Psalm 3:3**

God, You are a shield around me, You bestow Your glory on me and lift up my head. To You, O Lord, I cry aloud and You answer me from Your Holy Hill.

### **Psalm 4:1**

Arise, O Lord, deliver me, O my God. Answer me when I call to You, O my righteous God. Give me relief from my distress; be merciful to me and hear my prayer.

### **Psalm 5:1-3**

Give ear to my word, Lord, consider my sighing. Listen to my cry for help, my King and my God. For to You I pray. In the morning You hear my voice; in the morning I lay my request before You and wait in expectation.

### **Psalm 5:8**

God, please lead me in Your righteousness and make straight Your way before me.

### **Psalm 6:1-4**

God, please don't rebuke me in Your anger or discipline me in Your wrath. Be merciful to me for I am faint, heal me, for my bones are in agony, my soul is in anguish. How long, O Lord, how long. Please turn and deliver me because of Your unfailing love.

### **Psalm 8:1-2**

O Lord, my Lord, how majestic is Your Name in all the earth. You have set Your glory above the heavens, and from the lips of children and infants You have ordained praise. Please don't let my lips be silent.

### **Psalm 8:3-5**

God, when I consider the heavens the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars which You have set in place, I start to think, what is man that You are mindful of him, or the son of man that you care for him. You made Him a little lower than the angels and crowned him with glory and honor. O Lord, how majestic is Your Name in all the earth.

**Psalm 9:1-2**

I will praise You, O Lord, with all my heart. I will tell of all Your wonders. I will be glad and rejoice in You, I will sing praise to Your Name, O Most High.

**Psalm 9:19-20**

God, please arise, don't let man triumph. Let the nations be judged in Your presence; strike them with terror and let them know they are but men.

**Psalm 10:12**

Arise God, O Lord, lift up Your hand. Do not forget the helpless.

**Psalm 17:1, 7, 8**

Hear, O Lord, my righteous plea; listen to my cry, give ear to my prayer, show the wonder of Your great love. Keep me as the apple of Your eye; hide me in the shadow of Your wings.

**Psalm 18:1-3**

I love You, O Lord, my strength. You are my rock, my fortress and my deliverer. It is You in whom I take refuge. You are my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.

**Psalm 18:24-26**

God, You will reward me according to my righteousness, according to the cleanness of my hands. If I am faithful, You will show Yourself faithful. If I am blameless You will show Yourself blameless. If I am pure then You will show Yourself pure. However, if I am crooked, You will show me sharp powers of judgment.

**Psalm 19:12-14**

God, I cannot discern my errors. Forgive me for my hidden faults and keep me from willful sins so they will not rule over me. Then I will be blameless and not fall into a great transgression. May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in Your sight, O Lord, my Rock, my Redeemer.

**Psalm 22:1-2**

My God, my god, why have You forsaken me? Why are You so far from saving me, so far from the words of my groaning. O my God, I cry out by day, but You do not answer, by night, and I am not silent.

**Psalm 22:19-21**

But You, O Lord, be not far off; O my strength, come quickly to help me. Deliver my life from the sword, my precious life from the power of the dogs. Rescue me from the mouths of the lions, save me from the horns of the wild oxen.

**Psalm 23**

God, You are my shepherd, I shall not be in want. You make me lie down in green pastures, You lead me beside quiet waters, You restore my soul. You guide me in paths of righteousness for Your name's sake.

Even though I walk through the Valley of the Shadow of Death I will fear no evil, for You are with me. Your rod and Your staff will comfort me.

You anoint my head with oil, my cup overflows. Surely goodness and mercy will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

**Psalm 25:1-2**

To You, O Lord, I lift up my soul. In You I trust; do not let me be put to shame.

**Psalm 25:4-7**

God, please show me Your ways and teach me Your paths; guide me into truth and teach me, for You are God my Savior and my hope is in You all day long.

Remember, O Lord, Your great mercy and love for they are from of old.

God, please don't remember the sins of my youth and my rebellious ways, but remember me according to Your love, for You are good!!

**Psalm 25:11**

God, for the sake of Your Name, forgive my iniquities, even though there are so many.

**Psalm 25:16**

God, please turn to me and be gracious to me, for I am lonely and afflicted. The troubles of my heart have multiplied; free me from my anguish. God, please look upon my affliction and my distress; take away my sins . . . Guard my life and rescue me, let me not be put to shame.

**Psalm 26:2-3**

God, please test me and try me, examine my heart and my mind; for Your love is ever before me.

**Psalm 26:8-9**

God, I love the house where You live, and the place Your glory dwells. Please do not take away my soul along with sinners.

**Psalm 27:1**

God, You are my light and my salvation, I will not fear. God, You are the stronghold of my life, I will not be afraid.

**Psalm 27:4**

God, there is one thing I want to ask from you. This is what I will seek: may I please dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life. For I want to gaze upon Your beauty and seek You in Your temple. For in the day of trouble I know You will keep me safe in Your dwelling, and I know You will hide me in the shelter of Your tabernacle and set my feet upon the Rock.

**Psalm 27:7**

God, please hear my voice when I call. Please be merciful to me and answer me. My heart says of You, "Seek His face." Therefore, it is Your face I will seek. Please do not hide it from me, do not turn me away in Your anger, do not reject me or forsake me. But teach me Your way and lead me in a straight path.

**Psalm 28:1-2**

To You I call, O Lord my rock, do not turn a deaf ear to me. For if you remain silent I will be like those who have gone down to the pit.

Hear my cry for mercy as I call to You for help. As I lift my hands towards Your most holy place.

**Psalm 28:9**

God, save Your people and bless Your inheritance; be their shepherd and carry them forever.

**Psalm 30:8**

To you, O Lord, I called; to the Lord I cried for mercy. Hear and be merciful to me.

**Psalm 31:2-5**

God, please turn Your ear to me, come quickly and rescue me; be my rock of refuge, a strong fortress to save me.

Please free me from the trap that is set for me, for You are my refuge.

For into Your hands I commit my Spirit. Redeem me, O Lord, the God of truth.

**Psalm 31:9**

God, please be merciful to me, for I am in distress; my eyes grow weak with sorrow, my soul and my body with grief. My life is consumed by anguish and my years by groaning; my strength fails because of my affliction and my bones grow weak.

**Psalm 31:16**

God, let Your face shine upon me, save me in your unfailing love. Please don't let me be put to shame.

**Psalm 32:3-5**

God, when I kept silent about my sin my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long. For day and night Your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was sapped as in the heat of summer.

Then I acknowledged my sin to You and did not cover up my iniquity. I said, I will confess my transgressions to the Lord and You forgave the guilt of my sin.

**Psalm 32:7**

God, You are my hiding place; You will protect me from trouble and surround me with songs of deliverance.

**Psalm 33:17-18**

God, I am well aware that a horse is a vain hope for deliverance. And I know that despite all its strength it cannot save me. But if I fear You (the Lord) Your eyes will be on me and if I put my hope in Your unfailing love I will be delivered!!!

**Psalm 35:23**

O God, do not be far from me. Awake and rise to my defense. Contend for me, and vindicate me in Your righteousness.

**Psalm 36:5**

God, Your love reaches to the heavens and Your faithfulness stretches to the sky. Your righteousness is like the mighty mountains, and Your justice is like the great deep. Yet, Lord, you preserve man and beast. How priceless is your unfailing love.

**Psalm 38**

God, please do not rebuke me in Your anger or discipline me in Your wrath. Because of Your wrath there is no health in my body. My bones have no soundness because of my sin.

My guilt has overwhelmed me like a burden too heavy to bear. I am feeble and utterly crushed; I groan in the anguish of my heart.

All my longings lie open before You. My sighing is not hidden from You. My heart pounds, my strength fails me, even the light has gone from my eyes. I am about to fall and my pain is ever with me.

I confess my iniquity. I am troubled by my sin. O Lord, do not forsake me, be not far from me, and show me Jesus.

**Psalm 39:4-7**

God, show me life's end and the number of my days. Let me know how fleeting this life is. You have made my days a mere handbreadth and the span of my years is nothing before you, for my life is nothing more than a breath, I am a mere phantom that goes to and fro. I bustle about but only in vain. I heap up wealth, yet I don't know who will get it. But now, Lord, what do I look for? My hope is in You.

**Psalm 39:8-13**

God, save me from my transgressions, do not make me a scorn of fools. Remove Your scourge from me; I am overcome by the blow of Your hand.

For God, You rebuke and discipline men for their sins. You consume their wealth like a moth, each man is but a breath.

Hear my prayer, O Lord, listen to my cry for help; be not deaf to my weeping. For I dwell with You, one who lives abroad, like all my fathers. Turn Your eyes away from me, that I may become cheerful again, before I depart and am no more.

**Psalm 40:1-3**

God, I waited patiently for You and You turned to me and heard my cry and lifted me out of the slimy pit, out of mud and mire; and set my feet upon a Rock and gave me a firm place to stand.

You put a new song in my mouth, a hymn of praise to You, my God. I pray that many will see and fear and put their trust in You.

**Psalm 40:11-13**

**Psalm 42**

**Psalm 43:1**

Vindicate me, O God, and plead my cause for an ungodly nation.

**Psalm 44:6-8**

God, I do not trust in my talent, for my skills do not bring me victory. It is in You, God, I will boast all day long and praise Your name forever.

**Psalm 51:1-4**

God, have mercy on me according to Your unfailing love; according to Your great compassion blot out my transgression. Wash away my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin, for I know my transgressions and my sin is always before me. Against You and You only have I sinned and done evil in Your sight.

**Psalm 51:7-12**

God, cleanse me with hyssop and I will be clean, wash me and I will be whiter than snow.

God, please let me hear Your joy and gladness; let my bones You have crushed rejoice. Hide Your face from my sins and blot out my iniquity.

**Psalm 51:15-17**

**Psalm 54:1-2**

**Psalm 55:1-2**

God, please listen to my prayer and do not ignore my plea; hear me and answer me. My thoughts trouble me and I am distraught.

**Psalm 55:9-11**

God, confuse the wicked and confound their speech, for I see violence and strife in our country. Day and night people prowl about and malice and abuse are within it. Destructive forces are at work in our country, threats and lies never leave . . . please help.

**Psalm 55:17**

God, evening and morning and noon I cry in distress. Thank You, for hearing my voice.

**Psalm 56:8**

God, please record my lament and list my tears in Your scroll.

**Psalm 56:10-11**

In God whose word I praise, in the Lord whose word I praise. God, I trust in You. I am not afraid; what can man do to me.



**Psalm 57:1-2**

God, have mercy on me. Please have mercy on me, for in You my soul takes refuge in the shadow of Your wings until the disaster has passed. I cry out to You, O God, the Most High who fulfills His purpose in me.

**Psalm 57: 9-10**

God, I will praise You among the nations. I will sing of You among the peoples. For great is Your love, reaching to the heavens and great is Your faithfulness stretching to the skies.

**Psalm 60:5**

Save me and help me with Your right hand.

**Psalm 61:1-3**

God, hear my cry and listen to my prayer. From the ends of the earth I call to You. Lead me to the rock that is higher than I; for You have been my refuge.

**Psalm 62:1-2**

God, my soul finds rest in You alone. My salvation comes from You. You alone are my rock and my salvation, my fortress and I will never be shaken.

**Psalm 63:1-8**

God, You are my God, earnestly I seek You, my soul thirsts for You, my body longs for You in a dry and weary land where there is no water. I have seen you in Your sanctuary and beheld Your power and glory. Because Your love is better than life my lips will praise You. God, I will praise You as long as I live and in Your name I will lift up my hands. My soul will be satisfied with the richest of foods; with singing lips my mouth will praise You. On my bed I remember You; I think of You through the watches of the night because You are my help. I sing in the shadow of Your wings; my soul clings to You.

**Psalm 66:9-12**

God, You preserved my life and kept me from slipping. You tested me, You refined me like silver. You brought me into prison and laid burdens on my back. You let men ride over my head and I went through fire and water, but You brought me to a place of abundance.

**Psalm 67:1**

**Psalm 68:28, 30**

**Psalm 69:1-3**

**Psalm 69:6**

God, may those who hope in You not be disgraced because of me. O God, please may those who seek You not be put to shame because of me.

**Psalm 71:1-3**

God, it is in You I have taken refuge. Please never let me be put to shame. Rescue me and deliver me in Your righteousness; turn Your ear to me and save me. Be my rock of refuge where I can always go.

**Psalm 71:8-9**

God, my mouth is filled with Your praise, declaring Your splendor all day long. Please do not cast me away when I get old and do not forsake me when my strength is gone.

**Psalm 71:14-18**

God, because of You I will always have hope. Therefore, I will praise You more and more. My mouth will tell of Your righteousness and of Your salvation all day long, even though I can't comprehend its message.

God, I will proclaim Your mighty acts, O Sovereign. I will proclaim Your righteousness and Yours alone. God, since my youth You have taught me and to this day I declare Your marvelous deeds.

Even when I am old and gray, do not forsake me, O God, until I declare Your power to the next generation and Your might unto all who are to come.

**Psalm 73:23-26**

God, You are always with me. You hold me by my right hand, You guide me with Your counsel and afterward You will take me to Glory.

Whom have I in heaven but You, and God, earth has nothing I desire besides You. My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

**Psalm 74:22**

**Psalm 79:9**

Help us, O God our Savior, for the glory of Your name. Deliver us and please forgive us for Your name's sake.

**Psalm 80:3, 7, 19**

**Psalm 83:1**

God, please do not keep silent. Please do not be quiet. Please do not be still.

**Psalm 84:1-2**

God, how lovely is Your dwelling place, O Lord Almighty!!! My soul yearns and even faints for the courts of the Lord. My heart and my flesh cry out for the living God.

**Psalm 84:8-10**

Hear my prayer, O God Almighty, please listen to me, O God of Jacob. Look upon our shield (Jesus Christ), look with favor on Your anointed one (the Savior of the world).

For it is better for me to have one day in Your courts than a thousand elsewhere. I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of the wicked.

For You, Lord God, are a sun and a shield, bestowing favor and honor. For You do not withhold anything good from those whose walk is blameless.

**Psalm 85:4,7**

Restore us again, O God our Savior, and put away Your displeasure towards us. Show us Your unfailing love and grant us Your salvation.

**Psalm 86:1-4**

God, please hear me and answer me, for I am poor and needy. Guard my life for I am devoted to You.

**Psalm 86:11**
